



Playtime Scheduler

Playtime Scheduler (PTS) is a website (not an app) that allows members to sign up for PTS identified sessions on the FPC Calendar.

FPC encourages all members to set up an account on PTS. Players need an account to use this easy-to-use sign-up software. Players with a PTS account will receive an email when sessions are posted, typically on Saturday, to sign up to play the following week. **Cancel immediately if you become aware that you can't attend a session.**

If a venue is cancelled, the start time changes, or the number of registered players drops below the Minimum set for that session, then PTS automatically sends out an email, but that session is not cancelled unless an email comes from FPC.

Players can also communicate with session members using notes and emails.

In PTS sessions, players usually play with other players at or near their skill level and the courts are never crowded!

The **rating** you select in your PTS profile is extremely important and **must match** that of your skill level. Use your Pickleball Brackets club rating if you have one. Use a Rating Guide or contact the Ratings Committee if you need help.

PTS sessions are for players that have **paid court fees**, either yearly, monthly or the daily visitor's fee.

PTS sessions typically allow 6 players per court for regular play and 5 players per court for drills. Players can add their name to a **wait list** if the session is full.



To be fair and considerate to FPC members that use PTS, please abide by the following **FPC Rules**:

1. Only sign up for sessions that you plan to attend.
2. Sign up for only one regular play session per day.
3. Sign up for only one drill session per week on the day the session is posted. You can sign up for a second drill session 24 hours after the session is posted.
4. Being on the Wait List is considered being signed up for the session.
5. The Super Seniors Luck of the Draw session is primarily for players with a pickleball age of 70 and over. In 2024 this means they were born in 1954 or earlier. Players with a pickleball age of 68 or 69 can sign up for this session 24 hours after the session is posted.
6. Cancel out of a session at least **4 hours prior** to the session start time.
7. Posted notes in PTS are to be always respectful and they never are to be used to call out FPC members.
8. Visitors, defined as non-FPC members, can only sign up 24 hours after the session has been posted.
